

HAWKSHEAD HILL CHAPEL

Hawkshead Hill, Ambleside, Cumbria LA22 0PW

The Chapel is situated in the heart of the Lake District near Tarn Hows and the village of Hawkshead. The newly renovated chapel makes an ideal venue for small group use such as day retreats and leaders' away days.



The open plan chapel seats up to 40 and groups can extend onto the balcony area. Both areas are fully carpeted, light and airy, with a distinctive charm and peaceful atmosphere. Disabled parking, access and toilet are now available, along with an additional toilet. The kitchen is well-equipped with crockery and cutlery etc.

Outside, a summerhouse sits at the bottom of landscaped gardens near an outdoor baptistery. The grounds also include an orchard, graveyard and poustinia which provide different environments in which to sit, rest and reflect, whatever the weather.



There is plenty of accommodation nearby which could be used for longer visits, whilst using the chapel as a larger common area for church weekends/holiday weeks/Sunday worship.
