Woodbrooke

Woodbrooke Quaker Study Centre has its own 10-acre site which provides a refreshing oasis of calm in an urban setting. The house, a handsome Grade 2 listed building, was given to the Society of Friends by George Cadbury in 1903. It contains a well-stocked library with a major Quaker collection, and a spacious art room. Road, rail and other transport links are easy and efficient, and we are within reach of all the main attractions of the city and the Midlands region.

How to book

Please fill in the attached booking form and return with payment, if possible, at least three weeks before the course. Final papers and full travel details will be sent to you about 18 days before the course is due to start.

FEE: £166 for resident standard; £176 resident ensuite
£126 for non-resident including all meals except breakfast

TIMES: This weekend long course begins with the evening meal at 6:00pm on Friday and concludes with lunch on Sunday.

ACCOMMODATION: Wheelchair-accessible single and double rooms with washbasins. We cater for vegetarians and special diets. For additional accommodation before or after the course please contact us.

PAYMENT: Your credit card details or a 20% deposit by cheque is required to confirm a place on a course. Please see attached booking form.

CANCELLATIONS: For cancellations made 8 or more weeks before the start date of the course, the fee (including the 20% deposit) is 100% refundable. For cancellations made between 4 and 8 weeks before a course, your 20% deposit will be retained. Less than 4 weeks before a course, no refund will be issued - full payment is required.

The Meaning of Shalom: the harmony of God's kingdom

Who is the course for?

This course is for anyone who wishes to deepen their understanding of the historic peace church tradition and the biblical vision of shalom.

The course

Shalom is the Bible's word for peace. Shalom is the hope of the prophets: enemies reconciled, injustices righted, hurts healed, fears calmed and communities prospering. God's mission is to bring the whole of creation into harmony; peace with God, peace between the nations, peace with the created order. Followers of Jesus are invited to work with God in this peace-making mission, to be 'shalom activists'. Working from a peace church perspective, this course offers an opportunity to explore the meaning of shalom in all its richness and depth and to consider what it means to be 'shalom activists' in the world today.

What can I hope to gain?

Participants will gain a deeper understanding of the meaning of shalom in all its richness and an appreciation of commonalities and differences within the historic peace church tradition.

Leaders

Stuart Masters is one of Woodbrooke's two Senior Programme Leaders. He is interested in tracing the links between the biblical promise of shalom and the Quaker vision of gospel order. **Stuart Murray Williams** is chair of the Anabaptist Network and the author of numerous books including *Post-Christendom: Church and Mission in a Strange New World*. **Noel Moules** is the founder and director of Workshop which runs programmes of applied Christian studies.
